Circle the Evaluation Method used to determine competency:

O = Observation

D = Demonstration

T = Written Test

If at any time a task was observed to be completed correctly during normal course of treatment with patients, it can be noted as competent. You do not need to do a specific test with the therapist.

For Infection Control - completion and passing of the annual OSHA Competency quiz is sufficient to mark therapist as competent.

Please ask Anisa from Credentials if therapist passed OSHA quiz.

Observation can also be done but is not necessary.
